

Wilmington Little League Parent Code of Conduct

The Wilmington Little League promotes character, sportsmanship, and the Six Pillars of Character: Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring, and Citizenship.

Parent/Guardian Expectations

- Support your child's enjoyment of the game; do not force participation.
 - Remember: Games are for kids, not adults.
 - Inform coaches of any condition that may affect safety.
- Model positive sportsmanship for all players, coaches, officials, and spectators.
- Avoid unsportsmanlike conduct (booing, taunting, profanity, refusing handshakes, etc.).
 - Respect officials' authority; address coaches only at appropriate times/places.
 - Teach your child to follow rules and resolve conflicts peacefully.
 - Require respect for all participants regardless of race, creed, color, sex, or ability.
 - Ensure a drug, tobacco, and alcohol-free environment at all events.
 - Refrain from sideline coaching unless you are an official coach.
 - Learn and follow league rules and policies.

Enforcement

The Board of Directors reviews violations. Consequences may include warnings, suspension, or expulsion from the league.

Special Procedures for Assaults

Any parent/guardian who physically or verbally assaults another person (player, coach, official, or volunteer) will be banned for one year, and their child removed from Wilmington Little League for the same period. After one year, reinstatement may be requested. A second offense results in a permanent ban for both parent and child.
