Batting Cages Rules

- 1. Teams are to use the cage assigned to their team/division only.
- 2. Cages are for Cooper City Optimist Baseball teams only.
- 3. Cage #1 (Stirling Road) and Batting Cage #2 (Palm Ave) are for team use only.
- 4. Cage #3 (between Fields 3 & 6) may be used for individual and/or team use.
- 5. Each team is allowed to reserve one (1) hour per week. No more than one (1) in advance.
- 6. Time slots not filled may be claimed only 24 hours in advance of that time slot regardless of the 1 hour per week rule, not any sooner than 24 hours.
- 7. At no time are players allowed in cage without a coach.
- 8. No cleats allowed in the cages.
- 9. Players and pitcher must wear helmets in cage.
- 10. One player in the cage at a time.
- 11. Any player in the cage must be registered with the Cooper City Optimist Baseball program.
- 12. Cage and surrounding area must be left clean. Pickup and dispose of all water bottles, garbage, etc. after use.
- 13. Cage must be locked after use.
- 14. Cage lock combination is for coaches only. Coaches are not to give combination to parents, players or friends.
- 15. Do not remove L-screen from cage.
- 16. No hitting balls against the batting cage fence.
- 17. If any of these rules are found to be violated the combination to the cages will be changed.
- 18. Violators of these rules will lose cage privileges.
