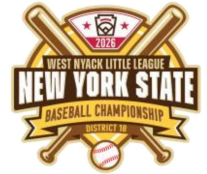

On behalf of District 18 Little League, we are excited to welcome you to the New York State Little League Baseball Championships. This year's tournament will be hosted by West Nyack Little League. Congratulations to all teams, leagues, coaches, players and parents on a successful Little League season! We are all very excited to have your teams join us for the tournament located at our historical Cesca Field (at Germonds Park) in the hamlet of West Nyack, NY. Cesca Field is named after our very own board member and head groundskeeper, Mr. Richard Cesca. On our board since the 1970s, Mr. Cesca has been an invaluable member who has served in a number of capacities, including coaching former player and NY Yankee broadcaster, John Flaherty. West Nyack Little League has been in existence since 1959 and continues to be one of the premier Little Leagues in NY District 18. The league provides skills, teamwork, and sportsmanship to more than 300 youth players over the last several decades.

Prior to the manager's meeting, there will be a barbecue and welcome dinner in the Pavillion at Germonds Park on the Pool Level.

Our Opening Ceremonies will take place on Saturday, July 25th at 9am at Cesca Field. There will be additional activities throughout the week, including a skills competition and Home Run Derby, and a Challenger Game. This is planned for Monday, July 27th with more information provided as we draw closer to the tournament.

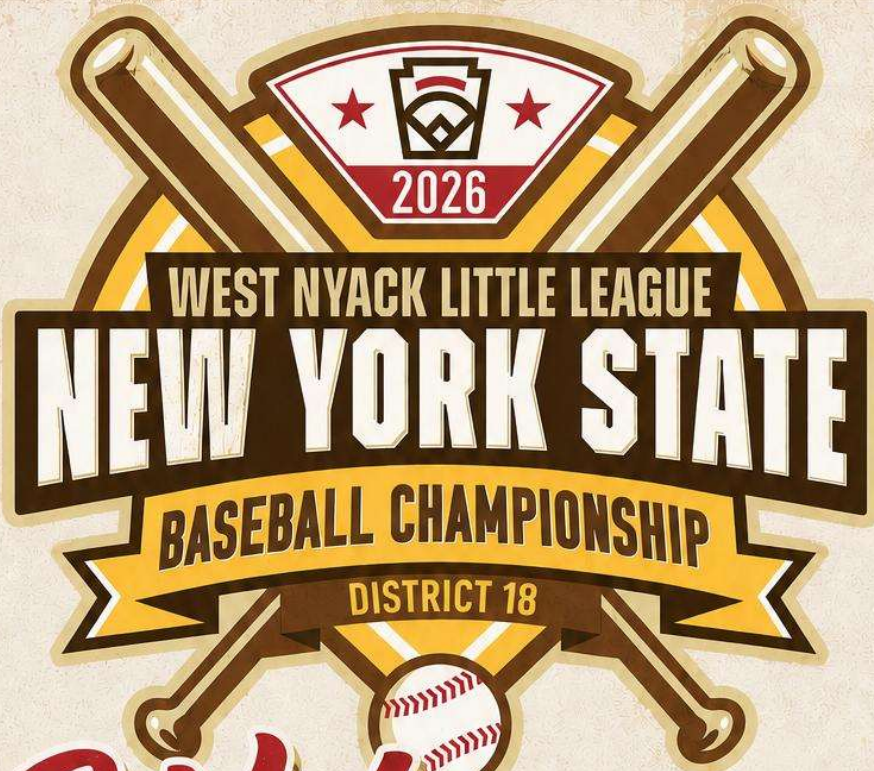

Germonds Park Directory



From Route 304 North (New City):

1. Route 304 South to Germonds Road.
2. Turn left and go past Albertus Magnus HS.
3. Germonds Road bears to the right (slight right turn) @ 1/4 mile.
4. Germonds Park is 1/2 mile ahead on right.
5. Go up hill to fields (past pool and picnic area)

From Route 304 South (Nanuet/Pearl River):

1. Route 304 North to Bardonia Road.
2. Turn right on Bardonia Road
3. At the end, make a left onto Germonds Road
4. Germonds Park is 1/4 mile ahead on left.
5. Go up hill to fields (past pool and picnic area)

1. Around the Horn Relay
2. Running Bases Relay

Miscellaneous Information

Playing Fields - Cesca, Finkel, and Medler Fields are all artificial turf infields with natural grass outfields. Per Little League rules, no metal spikes are permitted. Players must wear turf shoes, molded cleats, or sneakers. **NO GUM OR SUNFLOWER SEEDS ARE PERMITTED IN THE PARK.**

Concessions - Full service concession stand hot dogs, chicken nuggets, mozzarella sticks, meatball sub, fried pickles, pretzels, chips, candy, fruit, popcorn, nachos with cheese, ice cream, soda, water, Gatorade, slushies and more. Check the weekly special posted in the concession stand. Players and coaches will receive a drink and food option after each game played. We ask everyone to please refrain from outside food.

Umpires - We will be using the Little League umpires from Rockland County, NY. There will be **FOUR** umpires per game. All game umpires will be selected and approved by the District Administrator, Tournament Director, and WNLL League President

Uniforms - All uniforms must follow Little League standards. Coaches are expected to dress in a golf shirt, khaki shorts, and sneakers. No gym shorts, sandals, or flip flops are to be worn on the fields.

Format - Pool Play followed by Semifinals and Finals

Code of Conduct - The actions of managers, coaches, and spectators must be **exemplary** at all times. No profanity or unsportsmanlike conduct by any manager, coach, player or spectator will not be tolerated. Those who cannot follow the code of conduct will be removed from Cesca Field and its facilities

Batting Cages - There are two batting cages on site available for practice and before games. Please courteous and respectful of your time so all teams can take advantage. In the one hour prior to a gametime, the teams that are getting ready to play have priority in the batting cages.

Practice Fields - Finkel Field and Medler Field are both designated for team practice. No teams will practice on Cesca Field. A practice schedule will be created at the Manager's Meeting

Parking - We have ample parking in the lot adjacent to Cesca field. Additional parking may be found down the hill in the pool lot, in the rare case that the lot becomes full.

Memorabilia - We will be selling Tournament Programs for \$5 and Tournament T-shirts for \$20. If you are looking to purchase a shirt, we ask that you stop by the t-shirt tent to purchase/place your order.
