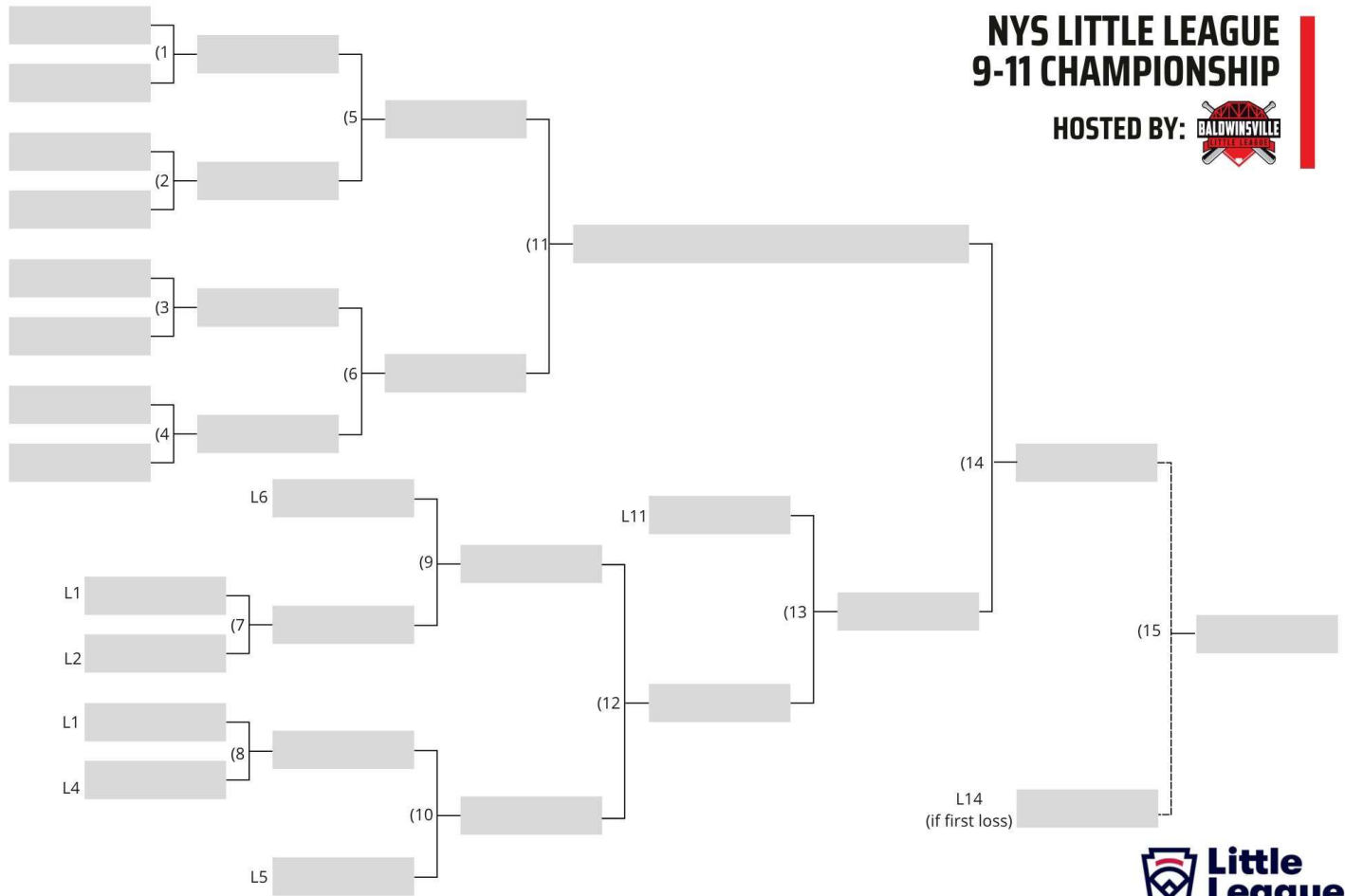

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR MANAGERS AND COACHES

Code of Conduct:

- The actions of players, managers, coaches, umpires, and league officials must be above reproach.
- Any player, manager, coach, umpire or league official who is involved in a verbal or physical altercation, or an incident of unsportsmanlike conduct at the game site or any other Little League activity is subject to disciplinary actions by the local league board or directors. Any unsportsmanlike actions by players, manager, coaches, or fans from the opposing team to disrupt the play of any player, especially the pitcher, will be dealt with immediately.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct or profanity by any manager, coach, player or spectator will not be tolerated.
- Players, managers, and coaches that become involved in any misconduct, on or off the field, or at their lodging, may be dismissed from the tournament. The activity and person will be reported to Little League Headquarters Tournament committee, the parent league DA and the League President.

Tournament Eligibility Affidavits:

- Team Managers are required to present their team affidavit to the Tournament Director upon arrival at the tournament site for review and verification. The affidavit will be signed and returned at the conclusion of each tournament game.
- **Medical Release Form:** Each Team Manager is required to have in their possession a Medical Release Form for each player listed on the affidavit. The medical release must have the signature of the participating player's parent/guardian.

Tournament Rules & Guidelines:

- The NY State 9-11 Baseball Tournament will be double elimination.
- The 2026 Tournament Rules, Guidelines, and Regulations are outlined in the Official Regulations, Playing Rules, and Operating Policies, as published by Little League International. They are also detailed in the Little League Rulebook App.
- All 2026 Tournament Rules, Guidelines, and Regulations are binding and will be strictly enforced throughout the tournament by umpires and tournament staff.

Tournament Schedule and Organization:

- Bracket slots will be assigned via random draw at the Managers' Meeting.
- The home team for the initial round of the tournament will be determined by the toss of a coin at the Managers' Meeting at the start of the tournament. The home team for subsequent games will be determined by coin toss 60 minutes before game time.
- The tournament director and staff reserve the right to change game dates, starting times, & field locations.
- Game balls will be supplied by the Host District.
- Umpires - We will have two umpires per game. Qualified umpires are selected and approved by the District Administrator, Tournament Director, and League President.
- Both teams will meet at the home plate area immediately at the conclusion of the game and shake hands.



Warm-Ups and Practice:

- Teams are expected to arrive one hour before game time at the tournament site.
- Teams will have use of batting cages for 20 minutes prior to the start of their game. Batting cage assignments are listed on the schedule of events. These times may be adjusted to stay on schedule.
- Each team will have 15 minutes of infield practice prior to the start time of the game. Infield practice assignments are listed on the schedule of events. These times may be adjusted to stay on schedule.
- Practice fields for teams not actively playing in a game are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Fields are available on off-days. Please request practice field reservations from the tournament director.

Dugout Guidelines:

- Only Managers, Coaches and Players listed on the official tournament eligibility affidavit are permitted in the dugout or playing field.
- Under no circumstances will coaching be permitted from anyone outside of the dugout area during games.
- Scorekeepers must be either a coach located in the dugout or stationed at the official scorer's table.

Uniform & Equipment:

- Uniforms and equipment will be the responsibility of the participating teams. All equipment MUST meet Little League specifications, including official patch placement. Responsibility for legal and proper equipment falls on the Team Manager.
- Make sure all players bring rubber cleats or turf cleats. Metal cleats are NOT allowed.
- Manager and Coach attire must always be in good taste.
- The managers of both teams will confirm with the umpire(s) at the pre-game plate conference that all equipment is proper and legal according to Little League rules. PENALTY: If illegal equipment is used during the game, the manager of the team will be removed for the remainder of the International Tournament, the player who used the illegal equipment will be ejected from the game.
- **Please pay particular attention to:**
 - **Catcher's Gear:** Must include helmet, dangling-type throat protector, chest protector, and shin guards.
 - **Batting Helmets:** Must meet NOCSAE specifications affixed with the NOCSAE symbol, be free of cracks or other visible damage, and all internal padding must not be missing, tattered torn, or frayed. Helmets may not be repainted and may not contain tape.
 - **Bats:** Must meet USA Baseball Bat standards (USABat) as adopted by Little League International. Bats must be free of any alternations/modifications, including: choke-knobs/choke-up assists.

Miscellaneous Information:

- Transportation to and from fields is the responsibility of teams, players, and/or families.
- Food and Drink - There will be hot food and snacks available on-site to purchase at the Baldwinsville Little League Snack Shack.
- PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT REEVES PARK. Service animals, as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) are permitted.
- Parking: We have ample parking at Reeves Park.
- Park Hours – Tournament staff will be at the park approx.. two hours prior to the first games of the day.
- Apparel - Tournament apparel will be available during an online pre-sale and available to order at Reeves Memorial Park on Saturday, 7/18 (delivery on Sunday, 7/19).
