As a **PLAYER**, I will:

- Conduct myself properly at all times.
- ✓ Do my best to listen, learn, and work hard to improve my skills.
- Be unselfish and support my teammates.
- ✔ Encourage good sportsmanship from my fellow players, coaches, and parents.
- Refrain from using violence, unfriendly language, or insults to others.
- ✓ Obey the rules of the game.
- ✓ Accept the decisions of the coach(es) and officials.
- Congratulate the other team after each game win or lose.

As a **PARENT***, I will:

- ✔ Be a positive role model for my child while conducting myself properly at all times.
- Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support only.
- Refrain from using violence, unfriendly language, or insults to others.
- Respect the coaches and officials before, during, and after each practice and/or game.
- ✓ Ensure that my child and I treat coaches, officials, and other players with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex, or ability.
- Remember that my child participates to have fun; this is for the kids, not the adults.

As a COACH and/or an OFFICIAL, I will:

- Respect the role and influence as an educator, imparting knowledge of the game as well as promoting the positive development of physical, social, and emotional behaviors.
- Responsibly adhere to all League rules and policies.
- ✓ Teach and abide by the rules of the game.
- ✓ Lead by example while actively promoting fun, fairness, and sportsmanship.
- ✓ Demand that all team members treat all players, coaches, officials, and parents with respect.
- ✔ Refrain from using violence, unfriendly language, or insults to others.
- ✓ Do my best to provide a safe and fair playing environment for all players.
- ✓ Remember that children are participating to have fun; this is for the kids, not the adults.

All players, parents*, coaches and officials associated with the Preble County Flag Football League shall abide by the guidelines set forth in the Code of Conduct. Failure to uphold the aforementioned will be subject to disciplinary action that may include, but is not limited to:

- Verbal warning
- Ejection
- Suspension
- Removal
