The Preble County NFL FLAG Football League's goal is to provide the best football experience to the youth of Preble County. We want the kids who participate to experience a faster-paced, more inclusive, more fun, and above all safer football experience so that they love and continue to play for years to come.

- <u>Faster-Paced</u>: No tackling, less timeouts, and no kickoffs all adds up to less stoppage time. This means shorter games usually less than an hour but also means more *actual* playtime for the kids. Also less players on the field allows for faster, more exciting games.
- More Inclusive: Co-ed allows both boys and girls to learn about and understand
 the basics of football. With only 5 to 7 players on the field at one time, it allows
 more players to touch the football and be involved in every play. All players will
 have the opportunity to play Quarterback, Running Back, and Receiver on
 offense.
- <u>Safer</u>: This is a NO Contact league. There is no tackling, diving, blocking, screening or fumbles allowed. Therefore, players are not required to wear any heavy equipment, such as helmets and shoulder pads. This creates an approachable atmosphere where kids can learn how to play and develop their skills without the aspect of physical contact.
- <u>Fun</u>: With fewer players on the field than traditional football, this allows greater engagement. Games are quick, competitive and every drive counts, especially in tournaments. It is the version of football you loved playing in your backyard—why ever stop?
