Three age divisions: C Division: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grades (co-ed),

B Division: 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grades (Boys/Girls separate

A Division: 5<sup>th</sup> and 6th grades (Boys/Girls separate)

**Player Eligibility:** The league is open to all boys and girls who will be in grades 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> at the beginning of the school year this coming September. **Youth in kindergarten are not eligible to participate in the fall program.** 

**Equipment:** All players must wear shin guards. Soccer shoes are recommended but not required. No jewelry can be worn by any player unless it is a medic alert tag. We ask that all children bring a ball to practice. One game ball will be provided to the team.

**Season Schedule:** All games will be played on Saturdays in Oneonta at Neawha Park starting the beginning of September and concluding the end of October. Games will be anytime between the hours of 9am - 3:30pm. Your game can be at any time between these hours. Schedules are built once all teams have been formed - approx. 3 weeks before the start of play.

**Town Players:** If you are from a neighboring town, please speak with your town coordinator if you have questions about practice days and times.

**Practice:** Practices for town teams will take place in their town. Oneonta teams will practice at Neawha Park. Practice nights and times are chosen by coaches, not by the rec staff. We try our best to accommodate people if their schedules conflict. If you choose to coach - you have the ability to choose your practice date/time!

**Player Notification:** Players will be notified of their team assignments after by their coach. **Please do not email in advance to find out what team your child has been assigned to.** If you have any special requests, please fill them out when signing up in the registration system. We cannot guarantee all requests.

Registration ends on August 6th, 2023. Any registration received after will not be guaranteed a spot or a shirt.

**App:** We use the Game Changer app for communication. All games and practice schedules will be posted on the app and any communication you need to have with your coach will be there.
