



- .5 A Coach, Assistant, or Manager ejected for a second time during a playing season shall not be allowed to return to their Team until reviewed by the League Board of Directors.
- .6 Any individual receiving a Red Card on the last session play date, including Tournament play, shall serve their suspension at their next scheduled NWISL game.

Section 3 Yellow Cards - Cautions

The following policy will be used to control individuals issued Yellow Cards.

- .1 Three (3) Yellow Cards in one season shall result in a One (1) Game suspension for the game following the third card.
- .2 A Fourth Yellow Card received shall result in an additional One (1) Game suspension for the next scheduled game.
- .3 A Fifth Yellow Card issued in a playing season shall result in a suspension for the remainder of the playing season.
- .4 Two (2) Yellow Cards issued within the same game shall result in ejection for the remainder of that game, plus suspension from the next scheduled or rescheduled game. The ejection will not be counted in the accumulation of Red Cards, but will be counted as Two (2) Yellow Cards.
- .5 Any Player receiving a Yellow Card, may be substituted for. The carded player may return into the game, if eligible, at the next substitution opportunity, with permission of the Referee.

Section 4 Insufficient Players due to Ejections

A game may not be abandoned due to insufficient remaining players, and penalized Team must play remainder of game minus ejected player(s).
