As a volunteer coach in the CVYBO, I agree to live by the following principles:

- The CVYBO League is a competitive league for grades 2nd-8th committed to the development of the children's basketball skills and their positive sportsmanship attitude.
- Each child's abilities vary; coaches are committed to working with each child to improve each child's basketball skills.
- Coaches model the behaviors they expect from their players and player's parents.
- It is expected that coaches respect all players, parents & referees.
- Verbal abuse or disrespectful comments will not be tolerated as it sets bad examples for our players.
- In the course of any competitive situation, we recognize that there are disputes or differences of opinions. Coaches are responsible for getting clarification but will not create situations of negative behavior or disrespect others in the dispute.
- The safety and emotional well-being of all players is one of the coach's top priorities.
- Coaches recognize that referees are committed to facilitating a fair game but they are human and can make mistakes. Referees, like coaches, are doing the best they can.
- It is the coach's responsibility to know all the rules of the game and of the league and ensure that their players also know the rules.
- The CVYBO can/will take action against any coach not following the above stated Code of Conduct.
